PARIS

- Paris One of Most Beautiful and Romantic Citiy, Brimming with Historic Associations and Remaining Vastly Influential in the Realms of Culture, Art, Fashion, Food and Design. A Larger Part of City, Including the Banks of the Seine, is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- **Eiffel Tower** is a wrought iron tower that stands 1,063 ft (324 m) tall. It was designed for the Exposition Universelle, a world fair held in Paris in 1889. It is currently the most famous symbol of Paris. It is also the most-visted attraction in the world.
- **Champs-Élysées** is one of the sights in Paris, created in 1667 by Louis XIV to improve the view from the "Tuileries" garden. This elegant and wide avenue was extended towards the end of the 18th century and now runs from the Place de la Concorde to the Arc de Triomphe. There are various opportunities to go shopping on the Champs-Elysée. The most important fashion brands in the world come from Paris. Besides you can discover the culinary side of France in various restaurants on the Champs-Elysée.
- L'Arc de Triomphe The monument was commissioned by Napoleon in 1806 as a tribute to his victories as Emperor of France and finally completed in 1836, long after his death. The Arc de Triomphe is decorated with battle scenes and battle sculptures. Tomb of the Unknown Soldier was placed under the arch in 1920, where an eternal flame burns in honor of the French dead of both world wars.
- Galeries Lafayette is a grand department store in Paris that is known for its upscale fashion, gourmet food, beautiful Art Nouveau architecture, and in-store activities. The store's beginnings date back to 1893 when two cousins from the Alsace, Théophile Bader and Alphonse Kahn, decided to open a small haberdashery shop in Paris on rue Lafayette. In the early 20th century, It would eventually become a department store.

BRUSSELS

- Brussels Known as the Capital of Europe, is Famous for Tintin, Comic, Luxury Chocolate, Waffles, French Fries and Brilliant Beer, as well as unique historical and arcgitectural landmarks.
- Atomium Halfway between sculpture and architecture, was designed and built for the Brussels World's Fair (1958), for which it was the flagship building and emblem. Representing an iron unit cell (9 iron atoms) magnified 165 billion times. The Atomium is an extraordinary construction which is a museum, an observation deck, an entertaining place, and a restaurant simultaneously.
- **Grand Place** is surrounded by opulent Baroque buildings, the resplendent Town Hall and the striking neo-Gothic King's House, which is now home to the Brussels City Museum. The square is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and is considered an architectural jewel.
- **Manneken Pis** also known as Little Man Pee, was designed in 1388, it is a small bronze statue that measures 50 cm and represents a small naked boy urinating into a fountain's basin. Many legends have surrounded this tiny, surprising statue. One of the legends, which was the little boy put out a fire with his tinkle, thus saving the city from being burnt down.

AMSTERDAM

- **Amsterdam** the world-famous 17th-century inner city. The pleasant Jordaan district boasts narrow streets, bustling cafés and stately merchant houses lining the famous canals. Discover the historic canal ring, which became a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2011.
- McArthurGlen Designer Outlet Roermond (Premium Shopping Outlet) – Set in the historic city centre of Roermond, is a premium fashion outlet mall located near the Dutch-German border in the south of the Netherlands. - **Zaanse Schans** with its traditional houses, windmills, warehouses and workshops, the historic village offers a preserved glimpse of what it was like to live in the Netherlands in the 18th and 19th centuries.
