VENICE

- Venice This ancient and historically important city was built on a group of 118 small islands that are separated by canals and linked by over 400 bridges, One of the most world-renowned Grand Canal thoroughfare. The Grand Canal and a Part of the City are Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- St. Mark's Square is the largest square in the city. Napoleon calls it "The Drawing Room of Europe". Two granite pillars carrying symbols of the two patron saints of Venice. The statue of St. Todaro, Theodore the city's first protector and the winged lion of St. Mark, armed with a sword, became the city's emblem.
- St. Mark's Cathedral is the church of the Roman Catholic, it became the episcopal seat of the Patriarch of Venice in 1807. The St. Mark's Cathedral glowed with the gold of its mosaics. This splendid Cathedral built in Italo-Byzantine and Gothic style is known for its remarkable multitude of domes and over 8,000 meter square of luminous mosaics and ornamentation. The magnificent Basilica which houses some of the most precious artworks and relics in Venice.
- St. Mark's Campanile is 98.6 meters high and thus the highest building in Venice. Originally the tower was a lighthouse, which is often called "El paron de casa" (Lord of the house). On top is an attic with effigies of the Lion of St Mark and golden statue of the Archangel Gabriel. The statue has big wings, when pushed by the wind, make it rotate. For the Venetians, when the angel is facing the Cathedral, it is a sign that there will be high water.
- **Doge's Palace** Built in 1340, is a palace Venetian Gothic style. For centuries the Doge's Palace had three fundamental roles: as the Doge residence, the seat of government and as the palace of justice. It became a Museo dell' Opera in 1923
- Bridge of Sighs Built in 1614, the" connected directly the inquisitors' offices in the Doge's Palace to the "New Prisons". The name of the bridge refers to the heavy sighs of convicts who, crossing the bridge to go to prison, knew they were not just loosing their liberty, probably seeing Venice for the last time. The movie "A Little Romance", It is said that lovers kissing under Bridges can last forever.

PADUA

- Padua is one of the oldest cities in northern Italy, it is home to many world-class sites and the frescoes that sparked the Italian Renaissance.
- Palazzo della Ragione the Salòn, a medieval market hall, town hall and palace of justice building in Padua. Located between Piazza della Frutta e Piazza delle Erbe. The upper floor was dedicated to the town and justice administration; while the ground floor still hosts the historical covered market of the city.
- Basilica di Sant'Antonio dedicated to the Assumption of Mary, also known as 'il Santo'. One of the eight international shrines recognized by the Holy See and a renowned place of pilgrimage.
- Prato della Valle is a 90,000-square-meter elliptical square in Padua, surrounded by a canal and bordered by a group of statues of well-known Paduans.

- Verona is a city in north-eastern Italy's Veneto region. In the year 2000 Verona has become a UNESCO World Heritage Site because of its urban structure and
- Romeo and Juliet Balcony Juliet's house is a tower house from between late 13th and early 14th century. On a stone in the wall there is a bas-relief of a hat. Popular tradition considers it the coat of arms of the Cappelletti or Capuleti, Juliet's family. Juliet's statue placed in the courtyard of the house, just under the famous balcony. Instead of gold he used bronze. The custom of touching the statue of Juliet to get lucky in love soon spread.

LAKE GARDA

- Lake Garda is renowned for its magnificent landscape and rich culture. Location in northern Italy and between Venice and Milan. Glaciers formed this alpine region at the end of the last ice age.
- Malcesine a small town on the northeastern shore of Lake Garda, backed by Mount Bardo at an altitude of 2218 meters, is the most dazzling lake shore and the most popular tourist town on Lake Garda.
- **Sirmione** Beautiful surroundings has Inspired and Fascinated numerous Artists, to the Point of Earning the Nickname "Peninsula of Poets", in additional, the thermal baths have become famous for the healing properties of the water.
- Scaligero Castle is a fortification built in 13th century on the waters of the lake by the Veronese Della Scala family, from whom it takes its name "Rocca Scaligera". The castle is surrounded by water on all sides, and only a suspension bridge can lead to the city. At the top of the tower can see the panoramic view of Sirmione.
- Grotte di Catullo is the name given to the ruins of a Roman villa on the southern shore of Lake Garda. The archaeological complex, still partially unearthed today, covers an area of about two hectares. To overcome the inclination of the rocky bank on which the building was set, large support structures, called substructions, were created in the northern part, and substantial cuts were made to model the rocky bank.
